Two major path systems go through the municipality of Casares.

The Gran Senda de Málaga (GR 249) circles the Province over a distance of 660 km in 35 stages. Stage 28 goes south from Genalguacil to Casares, a distance of 20.5 km. Stage 29 continues from Casares, first going south, then north-eastwards across the Sierra Bermeja, and finally south to Estepona, covering a total distance of 32.8 km. Within Casares, both stages follow parts of familiar routes such as Sierra Crestellina, Arroyo Hondo and Pasada del Pino.

The Senda Litoral (GR 92), which is partly still under construction, follows the coastline over a distance of 213 km. Stage 11 passes through Casares on its way from Estepona to S Luis de Sabinillas in Manilva, a distance of 12.8 km.

Basic data for these three sections are given in the following links. There is a great deal more information on the Gran Senda, and the reader's attention is directed towards its website and guidebook. In the links that follow, for each of the three stages that pass through Casares, there is a summary map, a brief description, and two maps with higher resolution and more detail.

Map gridlines and all map references cited refer to WGS84 and the UTM projection. This is applied for example in Google Earth, which can be used to show the precise location of a map reference in satellite view. Settings in GPS equipment and supporting software will need adjustment to this basis. All gridlines are 1 km apart.
